Concert Etiquette

Teaching our students concert etiquette is an important part of music education at Burleigh Manor Middle School. Please help model good etiquette by following the guidelines below.

1. Please refrain from talking or texting during a performance.
2. Please silence your cell phones and mute any other electronic devices.
3. Please refrain from taking flash photography and be mindful of other audience members' views when video recording the concert.
4. Please stay for the entire duration of the concert! All of our students have worked very hard to present tonight's performances.
5. Please be aware that some music selections may be performed consecutively without pause for applause. Please hold your applause until the conductor lowers their hands.
6. Please refrain from entering and exiting the auditorium during a performance.

COVID 19 Concert Protocol

- Masks are required inside of all HCPSS buildings. Please wear your mask **over your nose** while inside of the building.
- **Only students** are allowed in the fine arts hallway, cafeteria area, and backstage.
- After the concert, please **meet your child outside of the building** in the areas specified below:
 - Sixth grade - bus loop, **outside** of the main entrance
 - Seventh grade - **outside** of the gym entrance
 - Eighth grade - **outside** of the gym entrance
 - Sixth grade + older siblings - bus loop, **outside** of the main entrance
